



Alabama

Each Precinct in Alabama has multiple Republican committee people who are elected in the gubernatorial election year by the voters of the precinct and serve four years.

Qualifications

- Candidates must be a registered voter in the precinct.
- Candidate must be a registered Republican.

Process

- Running as an official candidate
 - If unopposed the candidate will be elected after the deadline of February 7th.
 - If contested candidates shall be elected by majority vote in the Republican primary election by the members of the precinct.
 - Must pay a fifty (50) dollar qualifying fee, as well as in some counties an annual fee.
 - Term begins on the day following the candidate's election.
- Filling a Vacancy
 - The county committee, with less than twenty (20) members, will fill all vacancies through election of a qualified candidate.
 - A county committee with more than twenty (20) members will fill the vacancy with a member of the committee from that precinct.

Deadlines

- Jan 1st 2014- Deadline to turn in any allocations to the number of precinct positions to the Steering Committee. Also the first day to qualify.
- February 7th 2014- Deadline to qualify.
- June 3rd 2014-Republican Primary Election.
