



Arizona

Precinct Committeemen/Committeewomen are elected in August of even-years and serve a two-year term. Each Precinct has one PC for every 125 registered Republican voters.

Qualifications

- Registered voting member of the Arizona Republican Party.
- Precinct Leaders must live within the district they represent.
- Must attend District Convention to be elected.

Process

Elected

- First an affidavit of qualification must be filled out and notarized.
- A signature petition form must be filled out and signed by 10-15 registered republicans who live in the precinct.
- The completed affidavit of qualification and signature petition forms can be mailed or hand delivered to any branch of the County Recorder's Office.

Appointed

- Submit a Precinct Committee member application to the district chairmen.
- The district chairmen, county chairmen, and county board of supervisors must approve you.

Who to Contact

- Contact your county or legislative district chairmen if you are interested in running. The Arizona GOP website contains a list of county and legislative chairmen as well as a Precinct Committeemen handbook.

Deadlines

- You can begin to file paperwork on Monday, April 28th but all paperwork must be turned in by 5:00pm on Wednesday, May 28, 2014 (postmarked does not count).
 - If you miss the filing deadline then you can run as a write in candidate. To be a write in candidate you must fill out the write-in nomination affidavit. The affidavit must be turned in by July 17, 2014.
