



Colorado Convention Guide

County Convention

County Conventions or Assemblies are held after the Precinct Caucus. Those delegates and alternates who were elected at the Precinct Caucus may participate in the County Convention or Assembly.

Qualifications

- Eligible to participate in Precinct Caucus held that same year
- Continuously registered Republican voter residing within the district

Process

- You must be elected at your Precinct Caucus as delegate or alternate by a majority vote

State Convention

The State Convention is held no later than 73 days before the primary election. To be a delegate, a majority at your county convention or assembly must vote you in.

Qualifications

- Should have attended local Precinct Caucus or County Convention
- Must have been elected delegate or alternate at the county convention
- Must have been elected by a plurality of persons present at the caucus or precinct

Process

- You are elected by a plurality vote at your local Precinct Caucus or County Convention
