



There are two Republican Precinct Committee Persons (PCP) in every precinct they are elected by the people of their precinct for a two-year term.

Qualifications

- Registered Republican voter residing within the precinct.
- Live within the precinct for at least 30 days prior to the Precinct Caucus.
- Registered to vote no later than 29 days before the Precinct Caucuses and affiliated as a Republican for at least 2 months (as shown on the Registration Books of the County Clerk and Recorder) **or**
- Are Registered Republican Electors who have attained the age of 18 or have become a naturalized citizen in the 12 months immediately preceding such Caucus or meeting.

Process

- In even numbered years each precinct holds a caucus. You must attend the caucus and inform the members of your intentions to run for Precinct Committee Person.
- All names of candidates for Precinct Committeeperson are announced during the Caucus prior to election. Results of the elections are announced by the Precinct Officials in the presence of the voters.
- If a vacancy occurs then the Vacancy Committee can appoint a Precinct Committee Person.
