



Rhode Island

Town committee members are elected for a two-year term, the number elected is set by local rules.

Qualifications

- A registered Republican voter residing within the district.

Process

- Town Committee members are elected at the Republican Caucus, which is held the first Tuesday in March on even-numbered years.

Party-Endorsed

- The Town Committee can endorse individuals and present their nominations at the caucus.
 - Most districts elect Town Committee members through party-endorsement.

Self-Endorsed

- Submit a written notice of candidacy to the Republican Town Chair, or Acting Chair, at least 14 days prior to the date of the caucus.
- In the event that the number of party-endorsed and self-endorsed candidates exceeds the number of seats available all Republicans attending the caucus will cast one vote. Candidates who receive a majority of the votes will be elected.
