



### **Maryland**

In each county a minimum of five members are elected to a County Central Committee who serve for 4 years. The County Central Committee works with the State and National Republican Party to organize and support Republican voters in their county.

### **Qualifications**

- A registered Republican voter residing in both:
  - The County
  - and District on which the represent (if the purpose of their election is to represent their district.)

### **Process**

- County Central Committee members are elected every Gubernatorial Election.
- File with your County Clerk:
  - Certificate of Candidacy
  - Statement of Organization
  - \$10 filling fee
  - Campaign Funds must be kept separate from personal bank accounts and reported to the Maryland Election Commission
