



Montana Convention Guide

County Delegate Convention

County Delegate Convention is held every presidential election year. Delegates are not elected to the convention. Precinct Committee members' votes are weighted to represent one-half (1/2) of the total number of votes cast in their precinct for the Republican candidates for Governor in the most recent primary election.

Qualifications

- A registered voter and resident of the district.

Process

- Anyone can participate but a Precinct Committee member's vote has more weight.

State Delegate Convention

State Conventions are held every four years. The State Chairmen will issue a call for the convention stating the time and place as well as establish how many delegates each district is allowed.

Qualifications

- A registered voter and resident of the district.

Process

- Delegates and alternative delegates are elected at their County Delegate Convention
- Must be elected by a majority
