



Montana

Two precinct captains are elected or appointed for each precinct, a male and female, and serve a two-year term. If a county has less than 3 precincts then 4 additional adjunct precinct members are appointed (2 men and 2 women).

Qualifications

- An individual who wishes to see the election of Republican Candidates and has a desire to actively support the Republican Party and is residing within the precinct and is registered to vote.

Process

- Check with County Committee to see if there is a vacancy

Non-Election Cycle

- Complete an Official Nomination Form and return it to the County Committee Chairperson
 - This form must be notarized

- Your nomination will be then voted on by members of the County Committee
