



## New Jersey

Two individuals, one male and one female, are elected from each unit of representation within the county and serve a two year term or until a replacement is elected. Units of representation are determined by number of Republican votes at the previous general election.

### Qualifications

- Active registered Republican residing in the representational district they wish to represent.
  - Most counties define active as voting in the previous primary election.

### Process

- Fill out a primary petition form with your county clerk
- You must receive a set number of signatures\*\*\* from individuals registered with the Republican party and residing within the area of representation
  - \*\*\*Check with municipal clerk to determine the number of signatures needed for your district.
- A Circulator Affidavit is to be signed and notarized
- The candidate must then sign a Candidate Certificate of Acceptance and take Oath of Allegiance.
  - This must be done in front of a notary or authorized officer

### Deadlines

- Petition forms must be filed with the municipal clerk by 4p.m. a minimum of 64 days before the primary election.
