



The number of Precinct Committee members varies per election district. Check with county election board to determine how many committeemen for your precinct. Committee members are elected every two years. Some districts elect in odd numbered years some even.

Qualifications

- Registered Republican residing within the precinct.
 - In some counties you must be affiliated with the party for at least 3 years

Process

- Obtain a Designation Petition from your county or town clerk
- The Petition is to be signed by a set number of registered voters within the precinct/county/village.
 - Check with county/town clerk to find how many signatures are needed
 - Form can be found:

- The form must be notarized by a certified notary
- The form must be turned into the county clerk within a certain filing period
 - Check with count/town clerk to find out filing deadlines
