



## **North Dakota Convention Guide**

### **District Committee**

District Committees are held every odd numbered year within fifteen days of the Precinct Caucus. Any incumbent members of the legislative assembly from the party, or the precinct committeemen may be part of the District Committee.

### **Qualifications**

- Each member of the committee must be a qualified elector within the district that they are running for.
- The officers of the district committee need not be precinct committeemen but they must be a voting members of the district committee

### **Process**

- Must be elected at the Precinct Caucus or part of the legislative assembly

### **State Convention**

- The state committee of each party consists of the chairman of each of the district committees of the party, the national committee people, the state house and senate leaders, and a representative of the state elected officials. The state committee shall meet on or before July first of each odd-numbered year.

### **Qualifications**

- Must be the chairman of the local district committee
- Must be a registered voter in the district you are representing

### **Process**

- Must be elected at the district committee
