



Pennsylvania Convention Guide

County Convention

The County Convention will be held at least three times every year. Elections of committeemen and committeewomen, one from each voting precinct, will take place every even numbered calendar year within thirty (30) days of the spring primary election results. The other meeting is the annual convention, and the Chair will decide the rest.

Qualifications

- Eligible to participate in Precinct meetings before the convention
- Need to be a registered Republican voter residing within the district

Process

- Elected by secret ballot at an organizational meeting of the General Membership.

State Convention

The State Convention is composed of the chairman of each County Committee who are elected at the County Committee and also alternates and delegates also elected by election at the County Committee.

Qualifications

- Must be the Chairman of the County Committee
- Must be elected as an alternate or delegate by the County Committee

Process

- Must attend precinct meetings
- Must be elected Chairman to the County Committee
- Delegated or elected as an alternate by secret ballot
