



In South Carolina the Precincts hold reorganization meetings every two years in the month of March. At these meetings new members are accepted and officers and delegates for the county convention are elected.

Qualifications

- Sign the Membership Roll at the reorganization meeting
- Have a current, valid voter registration for the precinct
- And either: 1) Be present at the Precinct meeting or 2) have your membership set forth in the poll list of the preceding primary election

Process

- Find out when the committee is holding its reorganization meeting
 - This usually occurs in March
- Attend the meeting and express your interest in becoming a member
 - Once you become a member you have the ability to hold office within the committee and be elected as a delegate to the county convention

Unorganized Precincts

- If your precinct is unorganized contact your county chairmen and request to hold an organizing meeting
