



## **South Dakota Convention Guide**

### **County Convention**

The County Central Committee shall meet in January of each odd numbered year and proceed by electing party officers. It shall consist of the precinct committeemen and women from each precinct in the county, the county officers, state committee people, and other elected Republican officials of the county. Officers will hold position for two years until their successors take over.

### **Qualifications**

- Need to be a registered Republican residing within the County you represent
- Must be elected as a precinct committee person in previous primary election

### **Process**

- Must be elected by a majority vote at the primary election as a precinct committee person or other Republican official in the county

### **State Convention**

The State Convention shall be held every even-numbered year at a time and place designated by the State Central Committee. The Convention shall be composed of the county chairman and vice chairman, state committee people, no more than three delegates elected at the primary election, and each precinct person of the county.

### **Qualifications**

- Need to be a registered republican in the county they represent
- Need to be a precinct person, state committee person, elected by a majority vote at the County Convention, or the county chairman or vice chairman.

### **Process**

- Elected as a precinct committee person in the primary election
- Attend and be elected at the County Convention
