



Tennessee Convention Guide

County Convention

The County Convention shall meet, every two years, at the time and place specified in order to reorganize the County party. The County Convention shall be composed of the Precinct Committeepersons of each precinct in the county.

Qualifications

- Need to be a registered Republican voter residing within the precinct you represent
- Need to be a Precinct person attending and selected at the Precinct Convention as a delegate to the County Convention

Process

- Must be elected in the former general election as a Precinct person and elected by majority at the Precinct Convention to be a delegate

State Executive Committee

The State Executive Committee shall consist of sixty-six (66) members elected in the general election every four years. There shall be one man and one women elected from each of the thirty-three (33) districts, by the people within their district.

Qualifications

- Need to be a “bona fide” Republican voter residing in the representing county
- Need to be actively involved with Republican events, Precinct and County Conventions, within the County you represent

Process

- Must be elected in the general election by a majority vote from the voters within the district you represent
- Must take an oath of office commencing September 15, following the election
