



Texas Convention Guide

County or District Convention

The County or District Convention shall consist of delegates and alternates elected from the previous Precinct Convention. Each Precinct shall vote one delegate and alternate for each twenty-five (25) votes. Likewise, the County or District Convention shall elect one delegate and alternate for the State Convention.

Qualifications

- Eligible to participate and in attendance at the Precinct Convention held prior to the County Convention
- Need to be a registered Republican voter residing with the county you represent

Process

- Elected as a delegate or alternate at the Precinct Convention by majority vote

State Convention

The State Convention is held biannually at the time and place determined by the State Republican Executive Committee (SREC) Chairman. One delegate and one alternate for each 350 votes are elected for the State Convention at the County or District Conventions.

Qualifications

- Need to be a registered Republican voter residing in the county you represent
- Need to be elected as a delegate or alternate from both the Precinct and County Conventions
- Need to attend the Precinct and County Convention

Process

- Elected at the County Convention by majority vote
