Texas Precinct structure is made up on volunteers and one elected Precinct Chairmen. (If you wish to volunteer with your precinct contact your local County Republican Committee.) The Precinct Chairmen is elected and serves a two-year term.

Qualifications

- A registered Republican residing within the Precinct

Process

- You must fill out an application for Precinct Chair and have it notarized and submitted and signed by your County Chair.

- Your name is placed on the ballot at your Precinct's Primary Election
- You must win be a majority
